Your window and door keys should be treated in a similar manner to your online passwords and ATM PIN numbers. Misplacing keys may affect your household insurance cover.

If you require additional keys it is important to recognise what type of key you have. See the table below showing key types and brands, including what to do if you require keys to be cut. NK Windows supplies superior European locking cylinders (or barrels) that use different keys compared to typical New Zealand-sourced locking systems.

European locking cylinders and keys installed into your windows and doors are stronger, and the keys thicker, than locally sourced products. As with all cylinders, please ensure you only use the correct key type – otherwise irreparable damage may occur which may void all warranties.

For security reasons NK Windows does not record clients' key cuts. If an existing key is not available for copying, a new cylinder will need to be fitted. Fitting new cylinders without a key is a time consuming technical procedure that risks damage to other parts of the door.
